Are You Eligible?

To be eligible for a volunteer firefighter position you must:

- Live within the Dorion area to provide an effective turnout to the Fire Station.
- Work collaboratively with other members of the Fire Department.
- Have a valid Ontario Driver's Licence, G level or higher, with the expectation to obtain a Class D licence with Z endorsement within one year of your acceptance to the Fire Department. Training will be provided.
- Receive a satisfactory driving record and criminal background check.
- Have the physical ability to carry out the duties of a volunteer firefighter position.
- Capable of attaining Firefighter Certification. Training will be provided.

Please note you must be 18 years of age or older to apply for a volunteer firefighter position.
