Novel Coronavirus (COVID – 19) Update

Monday January 18, 2021

Be advised that the Province of Ontario, effective January 14, 2021, has issued a new, **Lockdown – STAY-AT-HOME ORDER.**

This order requires everyone to remain at home with exceptions for essential purposes, such as going to the grocery store, pharmacy, accessing health care services, exercising, or doing essential work.

Items in the order include mandatory wearing of masks indoors at open businesses and outdoor gatherings being restricted to 5 people.

Remember we are all in this together.

As a result of this order the Municipal Office will be closed to the public until the Stay - at-Home order is lifted. **Essential** visits will be accommodated by appointment only.

All staff continue to be available during regular business hours by phone or email to address resident questions and concerns. To speak to a staff member, please call 807-857-2289 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. The Township of Dorion Public Works Department will continue to ensure all services and road maintenance continues as usual.

All other Municipal buildings remain closed.
